

Call for applications – The Rebecca Dratofsky Postdoctoral Scholarship in Nanoscience & Nanotechnology 2023,

The Lorry I. Lokey Interdisciplinary Center for Life Sciences & Engineering is offering one partial Postdoctoral scholarship for research to be carried out at the Technion in fields related to regenerative medicine and stem cell biology.

- -Candidates must have received their PhD degree no longer than 5 years ago.
- -The selected Postdoctoral researcher will be awarded up **to \$25,000** for one year against 14,600\$ matching by the hosting faculty member.

Please provide the following documents:

- A short cover letter.
- The candidate's CV, a publications list and a research program abstract
 up to 2 pages.
- The PhD **thesis abstract** (up to one page)
- Three **recommendation** letters
- A letter of commitment from the Technion host which should also include a brief summary of the reasons for recommending the candidate.

The candidate will inform his/her faculty that the application was submitted to the Lorry I. Lokey Interdisciplinary Center.

The Lorry I. Lokey Interdisciplinary Center will inform the host advisor and the faculty they belong to whether the scholarship was awarded within one month of the submission date.

If the applicant was selected - the notification letter will include the amount and the budget number of the support.

Following the approval letter, the host faculty will apply to the Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs with all the required documentation and the approval letter, in accordance with the Procedure for inviting Postdoctoral Fellows.
